## *Our Guarantee to you*

*Congratulations! Your pup is from some of the finest bloodlines.  
To the best of our knowledge, the bloodline is free of congenital or hereditary defects.*

These puppies are raised in our home with constant exposure to people and other pets so that they develop true Labrador temperament. We put a lot of time, energy, care and love into our pups. If you're fortunate enough to be adopting one, it's because we're sure you'll continue where we leave off.

Please have your puppy examined by your veterinarian within 72 hours of purchase. Your pup has received the best possible care and has had vaccines appropriate for his/her age at the time of purchase. It is important that you continue your puppy's health program and complete his/her immunization record to insure good health.

Your puppy should continue it's worming schedule (at 2,3,4,6,8 and 10 weeks of age) and be started on a monthly heart worm preventative (such as heartgard or Interceptor) and kept on it throughout his/her life. Intestinal parasites can be picked up anywhere that other dogs have been. Ticks are a big concern in this area. We recommend a Lyme vaccination (at 12 + 15 weeks) and a monthly flea and tick control (such as Frontline or Advantage). A rabies vaccination (at 12 - 16 weeks) must be administered by your veterinarian.

Please continue to feed your puppy Purina ProPlan puppy food for the first several months. Be sure not to overfeed your puppy as it has been scientifically proven that puppies kept lean during the first year of life are at decreased risk for hip dysplasia. The rest is based on appropriate nutrition and exercise. (We recommend Proplan for life, and avoiding giving you dog people food.)

The following health services are provided for each pup:

- Dewclaws removed
- Wormed at 2,3,4,6 and 8 weeks of age
- First shots (up to date when picked up)

Included with each pup is:

- copies of parents pedigree
- an AKC Limited Registration.
- a starter bag of puppy food
- a record of their immunization and deworming schedule
- Additionally, we send puppies home with a small blanket that smells like mom and their litter-mates to ease in their transition to their new homes.
